



### Work is almost complete!

Work over the last couple of weeks has seen surface preparation before the Resin Bound Gravel is laid, the final parts of walling completed and improvements to the lighting on site.

New lockable bollards have been installed to allow greater security for the church.

The turning circle has been reduced in size to allow more room for vehicles to turn whilst maintaining the green space and introducing a new green area in one corner.

Final works to the Rose Garden are beginning which will include a new bench, walling and planting. The new white roses are due to be planted in November. Both of the Blue Plaques on site (Richard III and Humphrey's Clock) will be reinstated in similar positions to where they were previously.

### Did you know...?

Amen Corner and the Church have strong associations with Richard III. The 'Boar' motif associated with King Richard can be found in various locations inside and outside of the church, and around Barnard Castle itself. An example can be seen in the image below. White roses have also been planted at the site previously to symbolise the 'House of York.'
