



### Work nears completion!

The final layout is now almost complete. The play area is taking shape with installation of the equipment and surfacing underway. The equipment gives the opportunity for active, imaginative and natural play.

The restoration of the green area adjacent to the Castle is reaching completion and includes new and refurbished benches, improved views to the River, repairs to the steps and a new flagpole. Final planting will take place in September.

The wall along Flatts Road has been re-built and some of the original coping stones recycled. Final installation of ironworks is due to commence next week. The final finish to the paths will be resin bound gravel and the last areas are due to be laid.
